CORONATION COMMITTEE.

REPORT of SPORTS COMMITTEE to GENERAL COMMITTEE relating to the  
Programme of Sports to be held on CORONATION DAY.

The Committee suggest that the same programme of Field Sports for Children be carried out as on Jubilee Day. The Adult Field Sports have been enlarged by the insertion of two extra Events making seven Events in all. They have considered the possibility of Decorated Vehicles and they find that the biggest factor to contend with is "time" and suggest as it is chiefly the Childrens Day that two classes be inserted in the official programme as follows:-

BOYS up to 15 years of age for the best decorated cycle  
GIRLS ..... ditto.....

Three prizes to be awarded in each Class.

In making this suggestion they ask that the combined parade from the London Road to commence at 12. 30. p. m. instead of 1. p. m. as on Jubilee Day, so as to allow extra time for the judging and arranging of these Events.

They also propose to offer 3 Prizes for the best Decorated Houses in the District, judging to take place on the morning of Coronation Day.

They ask for permission to enlarge the size of the Official Programme so as to be able to include all the Events with full particulars or prizes and particulars, as this appears to be the best way of informing the population of the Parishes as to what is taking place, providing the Programmes are printed and on sale a month or three weeks before the day.

The usual Side-shows will be run with a few additions, subject to the Committee being able to procure sufficient helpers to make the running of any additional Side-shows in an efficient manner.

The total cost in prize money amounts to £17. 6. 6. made up as follows :-
